- **The Full Farm Experience**

A three-hour experience where you interact with our animals, trail ride, fish in the lake, hike the trails, have a picnic with a pony, and more! Be sure to pack lunch, bug spray, and sunscreen. This package includes access to all amenities. Please contact if you would like to add or subtract any part of the package.

**Feathers and Fur Petting Zoo at Legacy Lane** Every single animal that participates in the Petting Zoo is “kid-tolerant”. They go through an evaluation process before they are selected to attend any event. We have multiple enclosures to compartmentalize each group for animal and human safety. We are constantly adding to our available animals, so be sure to check back for additional options.

If you wish to have a petting zoo with a Pony Party addition, liability waivers will be required for each rider.

Here are a few of the animals you can choose to socialize with:

- Rabbits
  - Lion Lops (Lion head x Lop ear hybrid)
  - English Angora
  - Holland Lops
  - “Heinz 57 rescues”- both small and large
- Ducks
  - We have rescued Pekin ducks that will be chosen from, per event, based on needs.
- Ponies
  - Mickey Blue Eyes- 2009 American Miniature Horse Buckskin Dun with blue eyes gelding.
  - Minnie Mare- 2012 American Miniature Horse Silver Dapple Dun with blue eyes mare.
  - Poncho-Hill- a 2013 Pinto gelding with a heart of gold. This man is the sweetest and brings his own party hat!
  - Mr. T- a 2004 Brown and white paint Shetland pony gelding
  - Bella-Skye- a 2001 sorrel Shetland mare. She is old and gold!

  - “Saturday” – 2022 Standard Donkey mare. She is absolutely the most loving animal we have on the farm.

  - Tillie-Rae is a Border Collie puppy that LOVES to play! She has a significant role as our up-and-coming working farm dog.
  - Katie-Belle is a mature Dachshund that loves to play and give kisses.
- Horses
  - Maggie Mae- American Quarter Horse Mare, beginner friendly
  - Sweet Texas- American Quarter Horse Mare, beginner friendly
  - Richard- a young Palomino Quarter Horse/Paint/Pinto gelding, advanced rider required
  - Suzie- Retired Canadian National Champion Arabian mare, beginner friendly
  - Ace- a young Arabian gelding that has a big personality, not rideable to the public
  - Meho- young Arabian gelding with the sweetest personality, not rideable to the public
  - Minnie-mare- an American Miniature horse mare with a sweet personality
  - Mickey Blue Eyes- an American Miniature horse gelding with a big personality. He loves to pull a cart
  - Poncho Hill- a pinto pony that loves a party! He is our #1 pony-party-pony and adores children.
  - Mr. T- an older guy, Shetland pony gelding, that will do anything you ask. Such a sweet pony that is amazing with children.
    - We have AMAZING horses for pony rides. All the horses are older, well-seasoned mares that spend their life teaching children horsemanship and horseback riding. I only offer my best lesson horses that are proven to be safe, well trained, and well mannered. They go through a rigorous evaluation process and desensitization before they are selected to “party”. Helmets will be provided. All animals are up to date on worming, vaccines, dental work, and farrier work.
- Cow
  - Nellie – Holstein heifer yearling
- Peacock
  - Justin is a juvenile male albino peacock. He is curious with a sense of humor and loves to check things out. He currently loves to hang out at the neighbors house but comes home to visit some days.
- Geese

- Waffles is a female goose. While she isn't affectionate, she does enjoy when we share treats with her.
- **Guineas**
  - We have 11 guineas that roam the property, helping control our bug population. They are very unique, noisy birds, that are entertaining to watch.
- **Trail riding:** pricing is a la carte but included in the "Farm Experience" package
  - Half hour trail ride \$45
  - Full hour trail ride \$75 per rider.
    - One rider per horse. Minimum age is 5 years old. While there is a reasonable weight limit, we require you to be able to mount your horse with the assistance of our mounting blocks. For your safety, and the safety of our horses, if you cannot mount, you cannot ride.
- **Fishing:** pricing is a la carte but included in the "Farm Experience" package
  - Fishing from bank \$25 per hour
  - Kayak Fishing \$50 per hour
  - Bring your fishing rod, or borrow one, for a chance to reel in brim, bass, or even catfish. Fish from the bank or borrow a kayak to paddle out into the lake. Catch and release or catch-and-keep.
    - Fishing license is required. Alligator warnings are posted. Guests are required to stay on Legacy Lane's property, and on our side of the lake. Life vests are required for all kayak fishing excursions.
- **Swimming**
  - Pool and lake swimming available \$25 per hour
    - No lifeguard on duty. All swimmers must be fully potty trained. No solo swimming.
- **Picnics**
  - Pack a lunch or door dash lunch to enjoy in one of our picnic areas. Please clean up after yourself and leave no trace. Trash cans can be found near and in the barn.
- **Hiking**
  - We have a varied terrain of hiking that is guaranteed to give you a workout. From our shaded trails to our sunny lake path, you can explore all parts of Legacy Lane.
  - Although our guinea fowl are present and do greatly help to control our insect population, Bug spray is HIGHLY recommended.
- **Arts and crafts**
  - We offer arts and crafts for kids of all ages. Choose to take your craft with you or choose to decorate the barn and leave a special piece of creativity for all to see.
- **Advisories and warnings:**

- Horses, ponies, goats, pigs, chickens, ducks, geese, peacock, bunnies, chicks, and turkeys. All animals are petting zoo friendly and love snacks. We do warn that any animal, with a mind of their own, is inherently dangerous. If it has teeth, it may bite. If it has feet, it may kick. If it has claws, it may scratch. While we do not anticipate any of our animals to demonstrate any of these actions, we are obliged to inform all visitors of this warning. Liability waivers are required and must be filled out entirely upon arrival.
- Snakes, alligators, insects, birds of prey, opossums, armadillos, raccoons, coyotes, fox, and other indigenous wild animals inhabit our property. Never approach a wild animal or attempt to interact with them.
- All dogs must remain under control while on the property. Please keep your dogs from harassing or chasing animals. Any unattended or unruly canines may be asked to remain on a leash. Please clean up after your animal.

Dogs are welcomed with open arms, leashes are optional, but you must maintain control over your canines, at all times. They are welcomed to swim in the lake, but not in the swimming pool.

We have a 24 hour cancellation policy. There is a 50% non-refundable deposit for all reservations.
