Parade Guidelines Per:

City of Dublin and Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr Parade Committee:

Please read and adhere to the RULES!

- 1. No Candy allowed!
- 2. Please follow all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials or faced the possibility of being barred from the parade. The Dublin Police Department reserves the right to remove an entrant from the parade either prior to or any time during the parade.
- Parade participants may not jump onto or off any float or moving vehicle and may not interfere with any other unit in the parade.
- Drivers of any and all vehicle or equipment in the parade must have a valid driver's license and <u>be at least 18 years of age</u>.
 Also, must have proof of liability insurance readily available upon request.
- 5. Drivers of vehicles or equipment will not be allowed to do tricks or perform any maneuver that may endanger themselves or others in the parade or along the parade route.
- Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any floats, in any vehicle, or on any person participating in the parade. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade may be removed from the line-up.
- 7. Riders of horses are responsible for poop bags for horses' use.

- 8. All pets in parade must be kept on leashes and held by someone strong enough to manage them. Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean-up or "pooper scooper" immediately following their entry.
- All entries must be able to maintain the pace and spacing as set by the parade officials. Failure to comply will result in removal from the parade route.
- 10. All entries, including marching bands, must move forward at all times along the parade route unless pre-approved and arranged by the parade officials. There will be no stopping or slowing down along the "oncamera" areas or for interviews to be conducted.
- 11. No person shall ride on the exterior of an automobile during the parade, except that one person may ride on the back of a convertible automobile.

12. No vendors are allowed!

13. All entries will control their noise levels. Any music played must be at a low volume such that it is only heard by those immediately in front of or adjacent to the said entry. All music must be instrumental only – I.e., no lyrics. Violators will not be allowed to participate in future parades.
