PLEASE NOTE NEW CITY OF DUBLIN INFORMATION – ROAD CONSTRUCTION MAY BE GOING ON AROUND TIME OF PARADE. THEY ARE INSTALLING A MEDIAN ON W. JACKSON STREET. WE WILL <u>NOT</u> BE ABLE TO ALLOW 18 WHEELERS IN THE PARADE ANY LONGER.

Line up is determined by the date the PAID entry fee is received. All entries will receive notification of their line-up number no later than Thursday before the parade. In the event of inclement weather, refunds will not be given. The St. Patrick's Parade is a fundraising event for the Dublin Civitan Club. All money raised goes to help with programs for children with disabilities.

New Rules and Regulations per City of Dublin

Participants may not throw items or candy at patrons, but may hand or otherwise distribute said items in such a manner as to avoid patrons from entering the parade route. Walk alongside the curb with your entry.

Parade participants may not jump onto or off of any float or moving vehicle and may not interfere with any other unit in the parade.

Drivers of any and all vehicles or equipment in the parade must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age. All motorized vehicles & atv; motorcycles must have proof of liability insurance readily available upon request. Must wear helmets on motorcycles and ATV's.

Drivers of vehicles or equipment will not be allowed to do tricks or perform any maneuvers that may endanger themselves or others in the parade or along the parade. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade may be removed from the lineup.

Horses and riders are welcome in the parade; however, all horses must use manure bags.

All pets in the Parade must be kept on leashes and held by someone strong enough to manage them. Animals participating in the Parade must be kept under control. Entries involving animals of any kind must provide immediate sanitary clean-up.

All entries will control their noise levels. Any music played must be at a low volume such that it is only heard by those immediately in front of or adjacent to the said entry. All music must be instrumental only – I.e., no lyrics. Violators will not be allowed to participate in future parades.

Parades are inherently family friendly events. All participants shall insure adherence to City ordinances and state law concerning public indecency and indecent acts. Lewd and vulgar acts will not be tolerated.

All entries must make best efforts to keep the parade moving at all times.

All entries, to the extent allowed by law, entrants desire to hold harmless and indemnify the City of Dublin and the Dublin Civitan Club and its successors and assigns from any and all liabilities, losses, claims, judgements, suits, fines, penalties, demands or expenses, including, but not limited to, all reasonable costs for defense and investigation thereof (including by not limited to attorney's fees, court costs and expert fees) for any loss claimed by anyone due to death, injury, or damage to persons or property arising out of, attributable to or resulting from the 2024 Civitan St. Patrick's Parade, except when such liability may result from the sole negligence of the City of Dublin and Dublin Civitan Club, its officers, directors, agents, servants and/or employees.
