Please join us for the **Nineteenth Annual Festival of Trees** hosted by the Conference Centers at Oconee Fall Line Technical College.

The Festival of Trees is a wonderful, community-wide holiday tradition. The trees are viewed and enjoyed by private events held in conference centers, and public events such as the *Sip N' See* and Chamber Business After Hours events. Local schools and assisted living facilities tour to view decorated trees. The trees are available and are open to the general public during the college's normal business hours. We hope that you join us by sponsoring a tree this year.

Trees are provided; however, decorations, ornaments, and lights are the responsibility of the participant. Extension cords are available for those trees not adjacent to outlets. Trees will be available to decorate on a first come, first served selection basis from **8 a.m. until 12 p.m. on Friday, November 21st and must be completely decorated no later than 6:00 p.m. Monday, November 24th** on both campuses. January 5-6, 2026 will be dates to undress trees on both campuses.

We will hold a *People's Choice* contest for favorite tree on each campus again this year. The winner of the *People's Choice* award will receive recognition on OFTC's social media pages and will receive free registration for the 2026 Festival of Trees. The 2024 winners were YKK AP in Dublin and the Washington County Sheriff's Office in Sandersville. Trees decorated by paid professionals are not eligible for consideration.
